Scottish office opened in Edinburgh in August 2010 with support from Equality & Human Rights Commission

Established as a separate charity in December 2011. Two staff and four local groups.

Funding from Scottish Government from March 2012.

- 21-26% of all children with nonresident father GUS* sweeps 1 and 2
- 33-35% of children of non-resident fathers have no contact with their father
