



1. Single parents in Germany

2. Economical Situation: Single parents are often poor

About 50 % of the households getting social welfare („Harz IV“) are single parents with children.

More than 75 % of single mothers with children under age 3 receive social welfare („Harz IV“).

3. Legal situation of custody

- Since 1998 parents keep joint *legal custody* after divorce if the court doesn't change it to single custody for one parent.
- Parents can claim for single custody only if joint custody doesn't work for some reasons.
- The court is able to give the right of locating the child („Aufenthaltsbestimmungsrecht“) to one parent - while joint *legal custody* is remaining. The court can not make an location order itself.

3. Legal situation of custody

- The court may decide that joint legal custody shall remain, even if parents neglect it.
- The court can not give an order for alternating residence – but it can give the right to the parent who is favouring shared parenting.
- The judge can make a precise parenting plan in which he/she orders shared parenting (50:50 or uneven)

Shared legal custody


